The Southern Caucasus, composed of Armenia, Azerbaijan and Georgia, has long been a focal point for change and a bridge between Asia and Europe. The region is in transition and has seen multiple inter-state and ethnic conflicts in its recent past, some of them escalating to full-scale warfare. The frequent lack of regional cooperation threatens to exacerbate environmental issues, themselves a source of potential conflict in the region.
