- Rapid economic development & Environmental problems
- The contradiction between environment and development
- Environmental pollution & ecological degradation
- The pollution of water and soil
- The total amount of major pollutants discharged

China's Environmental Situation

- First 20 years of this Century
- Population will go on increasing
- The total volume of its economy will be quadrupled
- The demand for resources will grow continuously
- The environmental pressure will be greater

- Commitments (Energy consumption per unit GDP, CO₂, the total discharge of the major pollutants)

Environmental CSOs in China

- ACEF conduct the second survey on the status quo of China's Environmental CSOs in 2008 after the first survey in 2005
- Report on the Development of China's Environmental CSOs
- Data Base on China's Environmental CSOs

Number of China's environmental CSOs

- By the end of October 2008
- 3539 environmental CSOs in China (Including Hongkong, Macau, Taiwan)
- 1309 CSOs initiated by the government
- 1382 students' unions and associations
- 508 grass root environmental NGOs
- 90 branches of international NGOs

Functions of China's environmental CSOs

- Influencing government environmental policies
- Supervising the government in exercising their responsibilities
- Protecting environmental rights of the public
- Promoting the public participation
- Developing international cooperation and exchange

ACEF (Annual Meeting)

- Annual Meeting of Environmental CSOs on Sustainable Development each year
- To promote mutual understanding
- To strengthen cooperation among CSOs
- 2008 Annual Meeting (ACEF + 8 CSOs)
- Theme: Promoting Public Participation & Low-Carbon Economy

7th Asia-Europe People's Forum

- 7th Asia – Europe People's Forum
- Workshop on Climate Change and Ecological Justice from Asian and European People's Perspectives
- To call on governments from Asia and Europe hand in hand in combating climate change
- “Common but differentiated responsibilities”
- To urge developed countries to fulfill their commitments in technology transfer to developing countries
