

Statement

**All China Environment Federation and China Environmental Protection Foundation
February 15, 2009, Nairobi, Kenya**

Firstly, regarding International Environment Government (IEG), we have three key points as follows,

1. IEG plays an important role in promoting global environment and sustainable development all over the world, while IEG at present has some problems and should need to be improved and made a reform.
2. The first thing now is to provide stable, adequate and predictable financial resources for the UNEP and GEF so as to promote global sustainable development.
3. It's necessary to strengthen the role of the GC/GMEF in guiding policy development so as to contribute to the solution of global environmental problems.

Secondly, regarding chemicals management, including mercury, we have two key points as follows,

1. Chemicals management aims to reduce the serious adverse effects of chemicals, including mercury, on human health and the environment, and all the countries should take action now to address the challenge of chemicals, including mercury.
2. We could take certain measures in a narrowly defined regime in the future and establish an effective system of funding and regional cooperation so as to solve chemical (including mercury) problems.

Finally, governments from different countries should attach great importance to NGOs and Civil Society Organizations should strengthen communication and cooperation each other.
