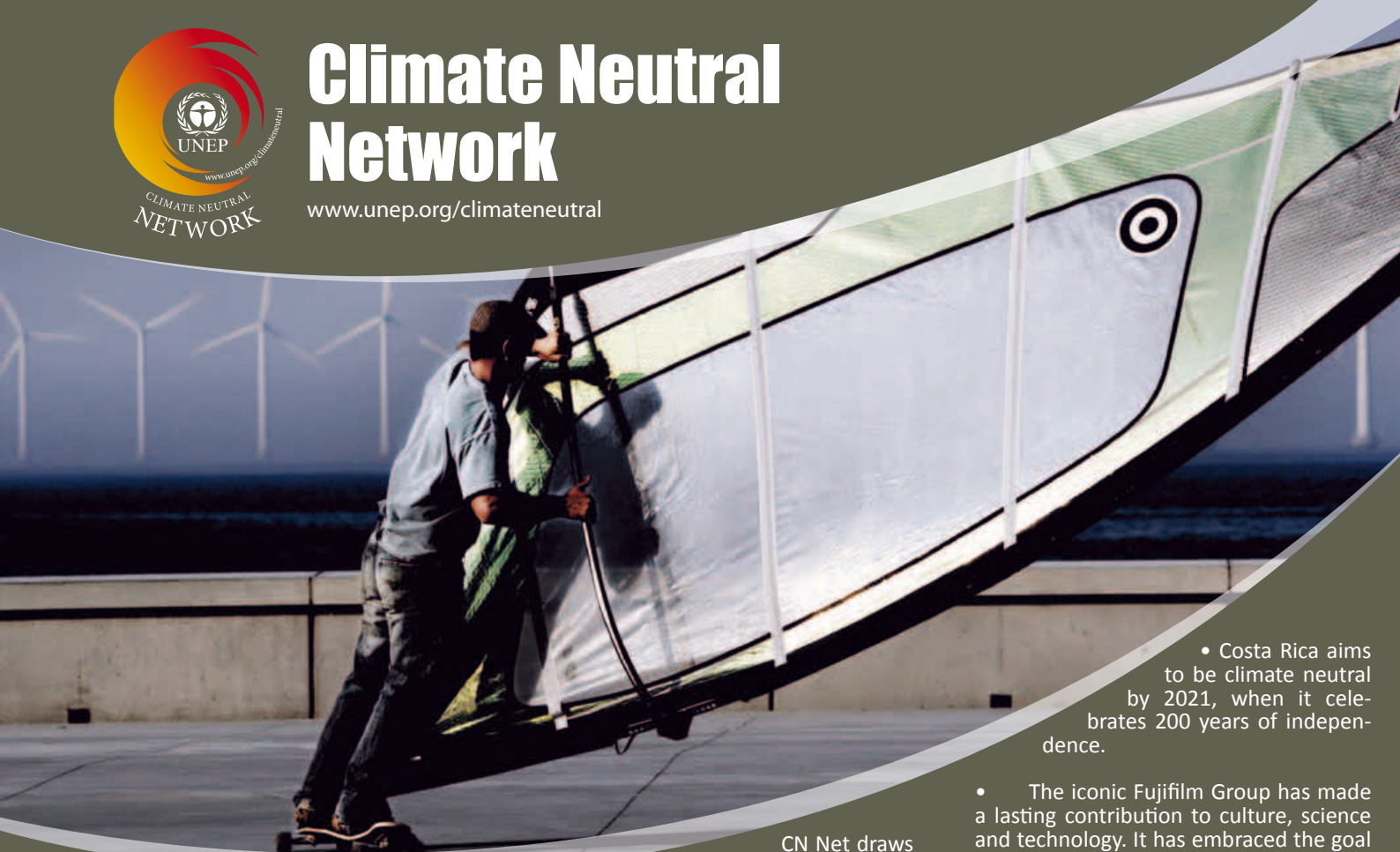

Launched in February 2008 as an initiative of the United Nations Environment Programme (UNEP), CN Net is at the forefront of the movement towards a global transition to low carbon economies and societies.

CN Net is a high profile platform for innovative and forward thinking pioneers to present to the world their strategies for moving towards climate neutrality, providing visibility and inspiring others.

Through an interactive website, and regular networking opportunities at major international events, CN Net is a dynamic forum for exchanging knowledge and sharing practical experience.

CN Net draws on the substantial resources of UNEP and the broader scientific community to provide up-to-date, online information on climate-related issues. CN Net provides critical tools and resources to assist in developing climate strategies, including reducing emissions and offsetting. It is a vibrant forum for sharing and growing knowledge.

Climate Neutral Pioneers

CN Net participants have some of the most innovative climate neutral strategies in the world:

• Costa Rica aims to be climate neutral by 2021, when it celebrates 200 years of independence.

• The iconic Fujifilm Group has made a lasting contribution to culture, science and technology. It has embraced the goal of climate neutrality by setting challenging emissions reduction targets at its six factories in Japan.

• The city of Arendal on Norway's south coast is a serious contender for the title of world capital of climate neutrality, becoming the hub of a wide network of businesses, sporting bodies and even music festivals that have adopted climate initiatives.

• The region of Wenjiang in south west China aims to become a 'zero carbon-emission' city by 2015, through a greening programme and emissions monitoring. Over 450 high-polluting enterprises have been either shut down or upgraded since 2000.

• French development NGO Planète Urgence offsets all emissions from its operations, provides financial incentives for employees to reduce their emissions, and carries out reforestation projects in developing countries.

• UNEP has the United Nations lead in reducing greenhouse gas emissions, and was the first intergovernmental organization to join the Network.

As the Network expands, so will its impact as a global movement combating climate change.
