

## WORKING GROUPS AND CASE STUDY PRESENTATIONS

Monday 16th January

In the morning, the Assembly broke into five **Working Groups** addressing the five main themes of the Assembly, plus two other Working Groups for French and Spanish speakers respectively.

Rapporteurs from these Working Groups will report at Plenary 4 on Tuesday morning, and their conclusions will be taken into account by the Contact Group established to finalise the draft resolution on the Common Framework for Action (Plenary 6, Tuesday afternoon).

Plenary 3 held under the chairmanship of Kilaparti Ramakrishna, Deputy Director of UNEP DPDL, and George Mucahi, Deputy General Secretary of COTU (Kenya) as Co-chairs, was the opportunity for delegates to discuss 13 case-studies presented by Trade Union organisations from the European Union, the USA, Canada, Argentina, New Caledonia, Belgium, Nigeria, Costa Rica, Uruguay, Bulgaria, Norway, Russia, Spain and Sweden. One of the objectives of the Trade Union Assembly on Labour and the Environment is to identify the most successful case-studies, and to seek their replication.
