- Estimated CO2 generated per year

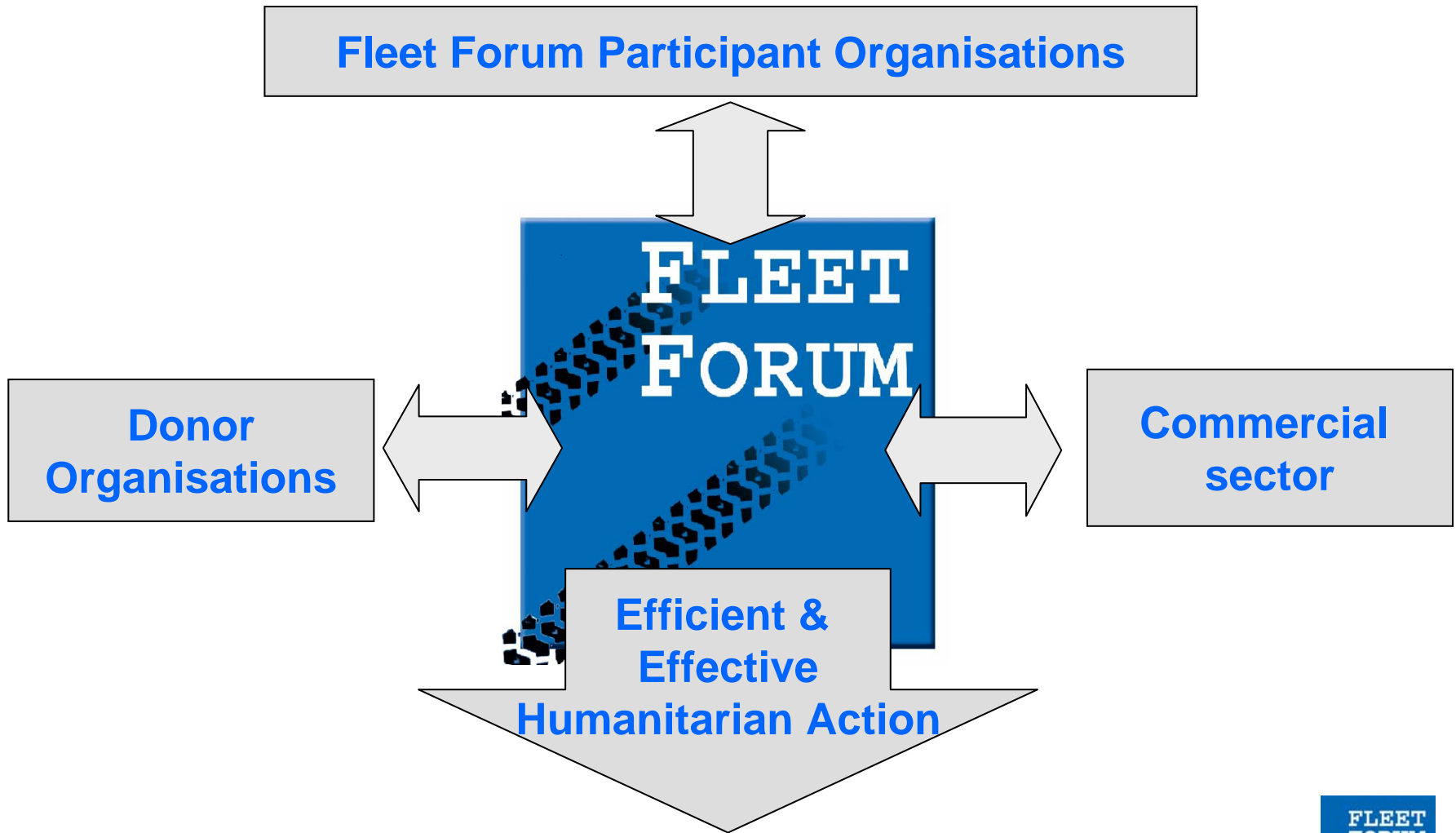

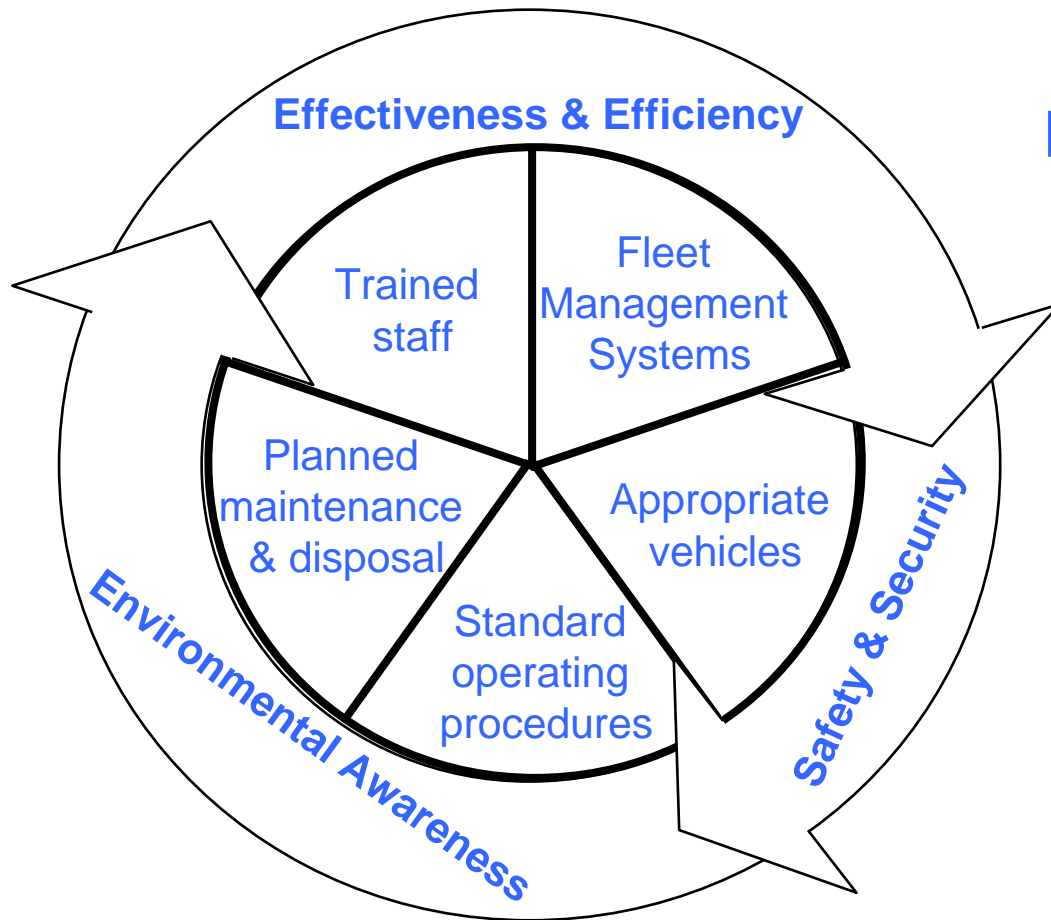


- Mandate of humanitarian agencies - assisting in development - includes responsibilities on health, environment and road safety.

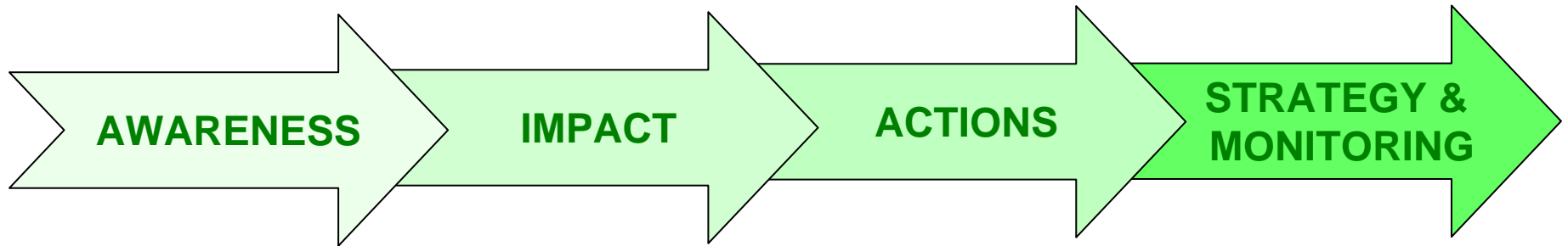

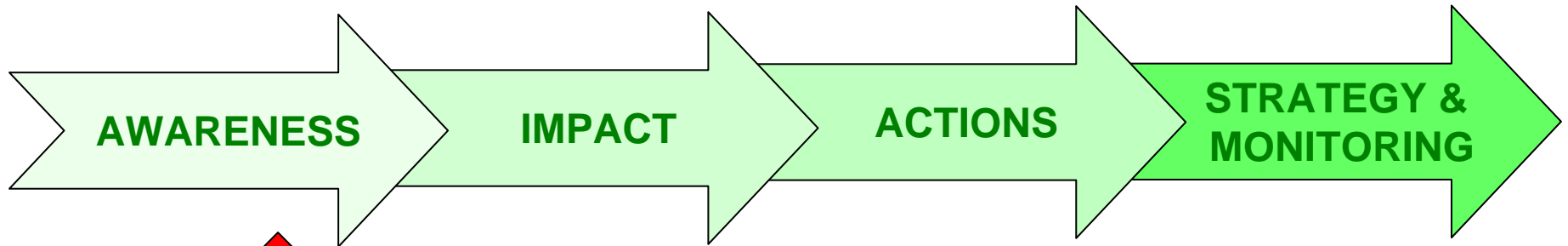
