

## **CULTURAL EVENT: City Tour & Dinner at the Búsuló Juhász Restaurant, Budapest, 28 April 2009**

Budapest, a city in a beautiful location with an outstanding urban landscape is rich in historical buildings and monuments. It has two main sides, the Buda side, the Pest side. On the Buda side, there are places of interest such as the Buda castle with the Royal Castle, the Holy Trinity Square, the Maria Magdalene Tower and others. On the Pest side is the downtown, as well as St Stephen Basilica, Heroes' Square and the large Market Hall. Between Buda and Pest are the beautiful bridges of Budapest, the most remarkable being Chain Bridge, Erzsebet Bridge, Liberty Bridge and Margit bridge.

The guided tour will terminate at the famous Búsuló Juhász restaurant on Kelenhegyi Street in the city for dinner at 8.30pm. The coach will depart from the Restaurant for Szentendre at 10.30pm.

The Búsuló Juhász restaurant opened in 1937 as a rest-house. It took almost 30 guest full years to put on a brand new garment. The new gown made history since the bar of the restaurant was the only one in the city of Budapest which had music and dancing possibilities till the morning. The young and luxurious life of the Búsuló Juhász ended in 1992 when a new spectacular revolution began. The long ago building was destroyed and from its ruins a new building raised.

The unique specialty of the **Búsuló Juhász** restaurant and its terraces is that in the course of eating and drinking their dinner, guests can enjoy the fascinating panorama of Budapest.

The tidbits are prepared in traditional Hungarian large earthenware oven or in home smoke-house not only enrich the selection of the house but also make it unique. The assortment of the menu is made up from the delicacies of the Hungarian bourgeois cuisine. It is completed by such specialties' like the freshly baked home bread or patés.

Participants will have the opportunity of listening and watching gypsy music.
