OBJECTIVES AND EXPECTATIONS

The objectives of the strategy workshop was to;

- Create awareness of transport related environmental issues
- Train practical use and application of the clean fleet management toolkit
- To calculate the CO2 emissions and air pollutants of the participating organisations (caused by their vehicle fleet).
- To explore which actions can be taken by the organisation to reduce the CO2 emissions and air pollutants.
- To start developing a clean fleet strategy.

The expectations of the participants were:

- To get more insight in how to calculate CO2 emissions and use the UNEP toolkit
- To support the participating organizations to develop a clean fleet strategy
- To use the outcome of this workshop for further communication to Fleet Forum members and promotion of the UNEP toolkit
- To identify comparable fleet data's in order to optimize fleet usage and characteristics to reduce gas emissions.
- To discuss clean fleet issues with other fleet users
- To receive update and training on clean fleet toolkit
- To receive updates on unleaded and low sulfur fuel availability
- To identify main issues for fleet cleaning strategy
- To provide participants with the tools to support going "green"
- To get a realistic cost impact analysis
- To get a greater understanding of clean fleet not just from an emissions perspective
- To learn more about methods of engaging support from Senior Management and Member States
