An overview of WFP

- Providing food aid to the hungry/poor of the world
 - Feed 88 million beneficiaries in over 78 different countries.
 - Logistics agency of the UN.
 - 5000 trucks, 200 ships, 50 planes at any point in time.
 - 3000 light vehicles and increasing
 - Large carbon footprint – INTERNAL and EXTERNAL
 - WFP executive staff have put the green on the agenda

External Carbon Footprint

- Participating in PCFV and Fleet Forum

Internal Carbon Footprint

- Introduction of vehicles leasing
- Introduction of Fleet Management (Fleetwave)
- Roll out of driver training
- Hybrid vehicles (not really an option)
- Partnership with UNEP (toolkit)

- Focused on light vehicle fleet
- Estimate carbon footprint
- Take reducing actions
- Take mitigating actions.
