Activities Held

From its inception in Sept 2002 PCFV been active in Asia, partnering / supporting organisations with keen interest in clean fuels and vehicles in the region. Partnering activities include:

- **USEPA Workshop on Clean Fuels in Vietnam**, 2003
- **3rd Global Partners Meeting** in New Delhi, India, 2004
- Clean Air Asia (CAI) in **Better Air Quality**, India, 2004
- JPEC **3rd Asian Petroleum Technology Symposium**, Malaysian, 2005.
- **2nd Asian Dialogue on Air Quality**, Bangkok, Thailand, 2005
- SEPA-USEPA **Low Sulphur Fuel Meeting**, Beijing 2005
- **Workshop on the phase-out of leaded gasoline in Afghanistan**, Bangkok, Thailand, 2005
- **3rd Asian Dialogue on Air Quality**, Manila, Philippines
- **Better Air Quality (BAQ) Meeting**, Indonesia, 2006
- Urbanization in Asia, Shanghai, May 2007

Direct support to national programs include MOU's executed with Indonesia (KPBB) and Afghanistan in 2005 & 2007 and 2006 respectively, containing substantial activities

Past

Focus was on

- Addressing public awareness, sensitization and education of stakeholders through specific Partner events
- Direct country support in implementation of activities

Approach appropriate in the period 2003-2005 particularly with Global work program focused on leaded gasoline phase-out as priority

Focus has not been region-wide but rather on key issues (eg Indonesia lead phase out)

Planned Approach & Activities

Develop strategic Partnerships with organizations with local networks for the implementation of PCFV activities in the region

- Focus on the 7 lead countries of Afghanistan, Myanmar, Laos, Mongolia, North Korea, Tajikistan and Uzbekistan
- Work with and support CAI-Asia's Fuel Roadmap public awareness campaign and the development of national roadmaps with time lines
- Develop national activities for low sulphur diesel standards in at least 3 target countries

Focus on vehicle work in the region

- Support the introduction in cleaner vehicles in the Asian region – for example support to Bus upgrade retrofit projects and clean fleet management projects in India and China
- Work on 2 and 3 Wheelers pilot project with CAI-Asia

Initiate Communication Outreach Program

- Publish material in Chinese [may consider additional language]
- Increase usage and awareness of PCFV publications and tools
- Active participation in BAQ regional events with Clean fuels and vehicles sessions (commencing with NOV'08 BAQ in Bangkok)
- Increase visibility of Web site and develop it into a reference authority for Clean Fuels and vehicles in Developing and Transition countries



Planned Approach & Activities continued

Recognize and utilize PCFV Partners network through formal collaboration

Promote PCFV within regional & sub-regional Ministerial sessions

Form a strategic Partnership with CAI-Asia

- Letter of intent with CAI-Asia as one possible key anchor partnerships', shared with aim of signing a 2/3 years strategic cooperation Agreement

Accelerating lead efforts

- National lead workshop in Afghanistan imminent
- Lead Blood testing imminent

Identify and work with PCFV Partner networks in the region to gain faster access
